

Section 3a, Idle Speed:

Previous: All watercraft are to observe Idle Speed\* except during the following periods:

|                         |                   |
|-------------------------|-------------------|
| April 15 thru Labor Day | 10:00AM - 8PM     |
| All other Times         | 10:00AM to Sunset |

New: All watercraft are to observe Idle speed at all times except during the hours of 10AM to 8PM.

Section 3b, Life Jackets

New, added to end: Stand Up Paddleboard (SUP) operators must be tethered to the paddleboard, or wear an approved personal flotation device (PFD) described above.

Section 3c, Boat Lights

New, added to end: Violators are subject to penalties and fines as outlined under "Penalties and Enforcements."

Section 3d, Swimming

Previous: Swimming, floating on rafts, tubes, or any flotation device is prohibited off of the Off Lake Property Owners Docks located in Birdhouse Cove.

New: Fishing, swimming, floating on rafts, tubes, or any flotation device is prohibited off of the Off Lake Property Owners Docks located in Birdhouse Cove.

Section 3f, Pleasure Boating, #2:

Previous: The traffic patterns for all watercraft will be counter clockwise at all times and must travel at least 50 feet from the shoreline and outside of the established markers and ide zone buoys.

New: The traffic patterns for all watercraft in the high speed areas will be counter clockwise at all times and must travel at least 50 feet from the shoreline and outside of the established markers and ide zone buoys.

Section 3f, #23:

Previous: All watercraft not running at high speeds must stay clear of the traffic lanes during the hours stipulated for high speed traffic when there are persons being towed present.

Changed to: All watercraft not running at high speeds must stay clear of the traffic lanes (behind the buoys and/or within 50' of the bank if buoys are not present) during the hours stipulated for high speed traffic when there are persons being towed present. Watercraft behind the buoys may go clockwise or counterclockwise while behind the buoys. Reminder: All watercraft operating behind buoys or within 50' of the shoreline are required to operate no faster than idle speed.

Section 3i, #1:

Previous: All non-motorized watercraft must stay clear of the traffic lanes for motorized watercraft (except to cross over from or to the center of the lake) during the hours stipulated for high speed traffic lane use. (Normally 10 AM to 8 PM summer hours).

Changed to: All non-motorized watercraft must stay behind the buoys and/or within 50' of the bank and clear of the traffic lanes for motorized watercraft during the hours stipulated for high speed traffic lane use, normally 10 AM to 8 PM.
