Board of Directors Meeting
October 12th, 2021, 7:00pm
Minutes

Those in attendance: Chairman Stege, Don Horn, Joe Stallsworth, Jeff Snodgrass, Steve Smith, Jake R., David Kent, and 1 freeholder was present.

Meeting called to order by Chairman Stege at 7:03pm.

Pledge of allegiance led by Chairman Stege.

September minutes were not read at this time.

Budget – 7:04pm – Adoption on resolution, \$115,760 proposed budget for 2022. The budget of web services is discussed on if there was enough money in the account to allow for SMS messaging. There may be enough funds, however if there is not the board can easily transfer over more funds to make up for it. At least \$5,000 additional from the state will be requested, which the budget is not accounting for at this time. There is a possibility it could be more, with the option of not taking or executing the funds. If they were taken, it would likely be placed into the cumm maintenance fund (\$11,000 currently). There is currently \$2,000 budgeted in the cumm improvement fund. Roughly \$63,000 out of the budget is actually savings. Jeff S motions to accept, Steve seconds, and the motion passes without objection. 2022 Budget has been adopted.

SMS Messaging – 7:12pm – SMS Messages coming soon from the board. More information to follow pending Jeff's research into the service.

Upcoming Elections – 7:13pm – Nominations for area 3 (Chairman Stege's district) need to be submitted no later than November 30th. Notice of the nomination will likely be published in the newspaper, if necessary, in addition to posting to the Lake's website and sent via email.

Riverview Discussion – 7:17pm – The board discussed the feasibility of Riverview houses becoming part of the LECD, and whether this would be beneficial for increasing the lake's finances.

Weed Treatment – 7:19pm – The final weed treatment was this previous Tuesday. The service provider stated to be very pleased with the cleanliness of the lake, and would rate it amongst one of the highest in the state.

Trick or Treating – 7:21pm – The exact date of the Trick or Treating is discussed. Whether it will be on Saturday or Sunday. The decision will likely be based on the communities' desires that are expressed on the community Facebook group.

Public Comment – 7:29pm – Strange cars in the neighborhood have been reported. A notice will be published on the details. The sheriff has been talked to as well about beach occupants that are not from the lake community. A black car also has been driving fast and recklessly around the lake at late hours.

Motion to adjourn by Jake, second by Joe, passes without objection. Meeting is adjourned 7:41pm.
